- They learnt how to distinguish edible and non-edible food.
- This is the last age of Prehistory.
- They built tombs like megaliths, menhirs and dolmens.
- It began when people learnt with the development of agriculture and livestock.
- They made a different product and exchanged it. This act of trading without money is called bartering.
- They used mud, stone, sticks and straw to build houses. As a result, the first villages appeared.
- They lived in caves. They made the first tools by carving stones.
- They invented the potter's wheel to make clay pots and the oven to bake them.
- They discovered how to melt metal in ovens and then shape and polish it.
- They gathered fruit and vegetables.
- They built walls to protect the towns and chose warriors to protect them.
- They invented new forms of transport, like carts with wheels and sailing boats.
- They made cave paintings, using their hands, brushes or blowing.
- Potters made pots and other containers with clay.
- There were blacksmiths.
