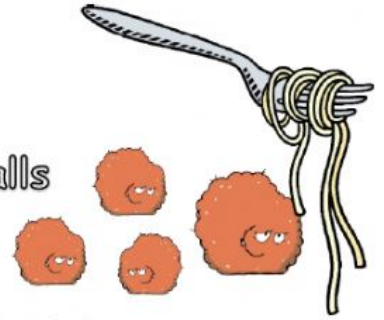




## Cloudy with a Chance of Meatballs
