RULES: We use the present simple when we talk about facts and routines. The <i>he</i> , <i>she</i> and <i>it</i> forms end with -s	
1	Add -s to most verbs: play --> <i>plays</i>
2	Add -es when a verb ends with -o, -sh, -ch or -x
3	Minus -y and add -ies when a verb ends with a consonant + y.
4	The third person of <i>have</i> is <i>has</i>
