RULES: We use the present simple when we talk about facts and routines. The <i>he, she</i> and <i>it</i> forms end with <i>-s</i>	
1	Add <i>-s</i> to most verbs: play --> <i>plays</i>
2	Add <i>-es</i> when a verb ends with <i>-o</i> , <i>-sh</i> , <i>-ch</i> or <i>-x</i>
3	Minus <i>-y</i> and add <i>-ies</i> when a verb ends with a consonant + <i>y</i> .
4	The third person of <i>have</i> is <i>has</i>
