

PRESENT PROGRESSIVE

RULES FOR PRESENT PARTICIPLE (V-ing)

1. Add -ING to most verbs	Speak ----- speaking clean ----- cleaning
2. If the verb finishes in silent "E", drop the "E" and add -ING	Leave ----- leaving Have ----- having
3. If the verb has <u>one syllable</u> and finish in CVC , double the final consonant and add -ING .	shop ----- shopping put ----- putting run ----- running
EXCEPTION: W, X, Y	buy ----- buying
