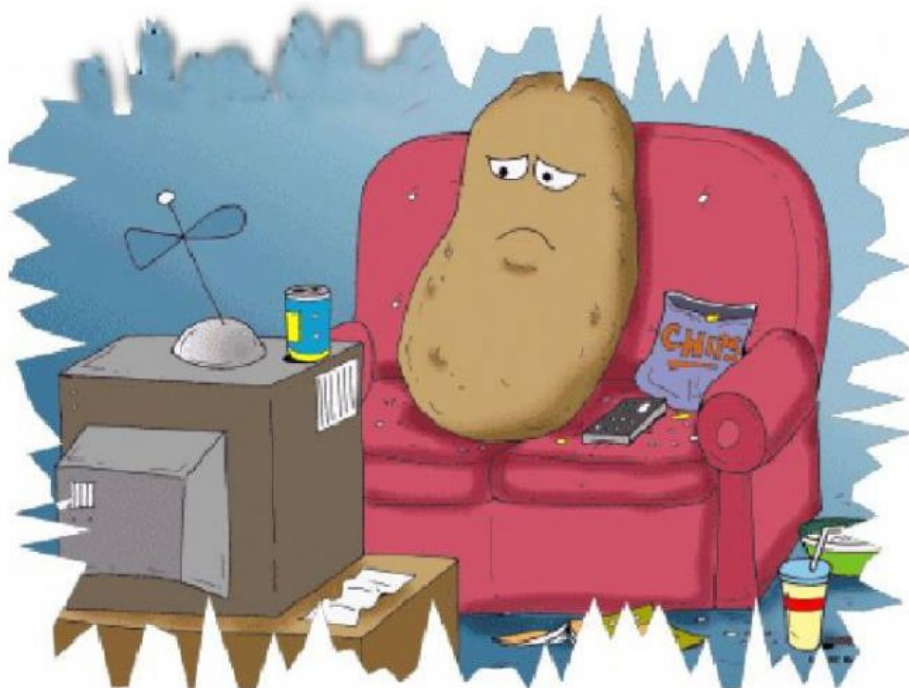

A generation of couch potatoes



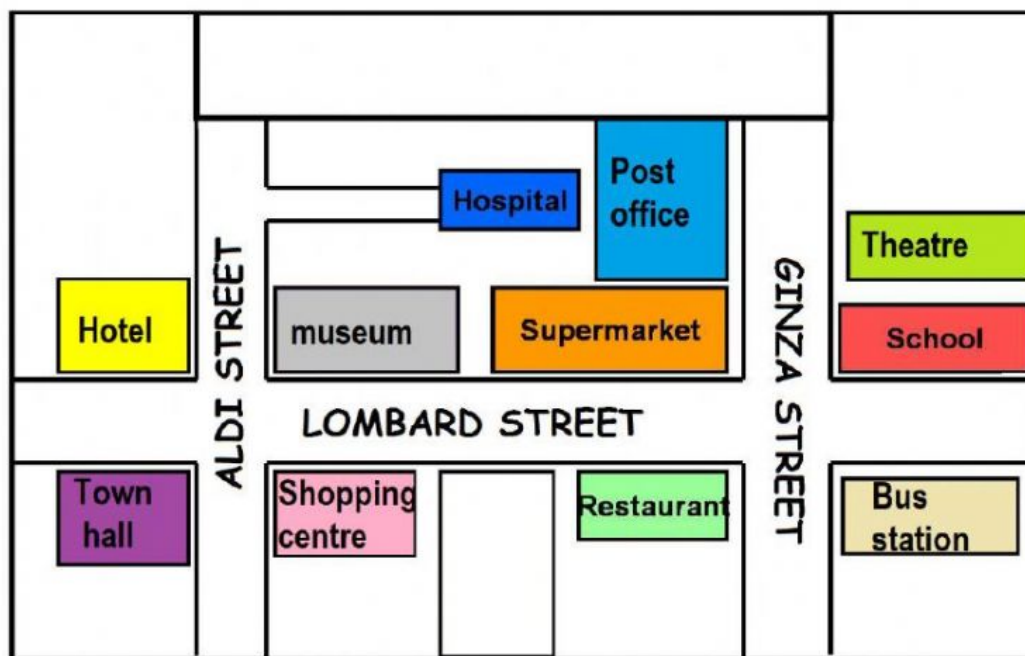
