Types of Conflicts (conflicts means problems)

Internal- facing problems with thoughts, emotions, or making decisions. Example: A character broke her mother's vase and is scared to tell her. Should she tell the truth or lie? Internal conflict

External: problems happening outside the character. Example: A character gets into an argument with his brother. Example 2: A bad guy runs from the police. Example 3: A presidential election where 2 candidates run against each other.
