Stages	Definitions
1	A small activity that teachers use to draw student's attention before introducing the main lesson.
2	The stage where the students get an opportunity to relate the target language to their personal life.
3	Whiteboard, books, registers, worksheet, slide projector and so on.
4	Teachers state what students will do/can do. This can be more than one.
5	The general outcome of the target language which the students can produce by the end of the lesson.
6	The stage where teachers introduce the new language
7	A set of activities and techniques in which you have considered for the students to practice the target language.
8	Feedback of the last activity (production), game, or homework.
