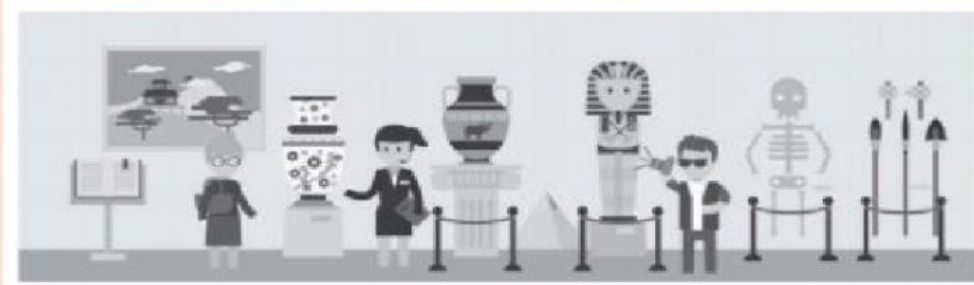


## Starters 3 - Mid-Term 2021
