



## PRESENT CONTINUOUS

### Affirmative form

Subject + am/is/are + present participle (V<sub>ing</sub>)

I + am + watching TV.

He  
She + is + looking nice at this moment.  
It

We  
They + are + playing football.  
You



EXAMPLE: Affirmative (+)

She is picking up (PICK UP) litter.



1. We

(PLANT) a tree.



2. I

(RECYCLE).



3. They

(USE) public transportation.



4. She

(RIDE) her bike.



5. You

(TURN OFF) the lights.



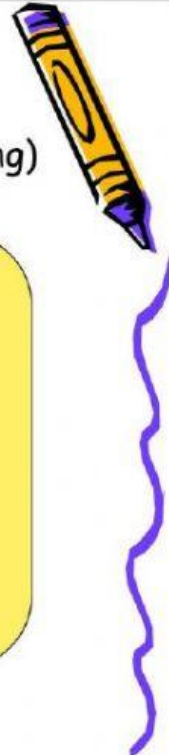
## Negative form

Subject + am/is/are + not + present participle (Ving)

I + am + not + watching TV.

He  
She + is + not + looking nice at this moment.  
It

We  
They + are + not + playing football.  
You



EXAMPLE: **Negative (-)**

**He is not using both sides of the paper.**



1. I

**(NOT/DONATE) the toys.**



2. Tom

**(NOT /TAKE) a short shower.**



3. They

**(NOT/DRINK) from a glass bottle.**



4. She  
in use.

**(NOT/UNPLUG) TV when not**



5. He  
brushing teeth.

**(NO/TURN OFF) water tap while**
