



PRESENT CONTINUOUS


Affirmative form

Subject + am/is/are + present participle (V_{ing})

I + am + watching TV.

He
She + is + looking nice at this moment.
It

We
They + are + playing football.
You



EXAMPLE: **Affirmative (+)**

She is picking up (PICK UP) litter.

(PLANT) a tree.



2. I

(RECYCLE).



3. They

(USE) public transportation.



4. She

(RIDE) her bike.



5. You

(TURN OFF) the lights.




Negative form

Subject + am/is/are + not + present participle (Ving)

I + am + not + watching TV.

He
She + is + not + looking nice at this moment.
It

We
They + are + not + playing football.
You



EXAMPLE: Negative (-)

He is not using both sides of the paper.

(NOT/DONATE) the toys.



2. Tom

(NOT /TAKE) a short shower.
