## 1. ADVERBS OF MANNER:

**Use:** To describe how and in what way the action of a verb is carried out.

	ADJECTIVE	ADVERB
Most of adjectives: + "ly"	Quick Strong	Quickly Strongly
Adjectives ending in -y: y(x) + "ily"	Happy Easy	Happily Easily
Adjectives ending in -e: e(x) + "ly"	Possible Forcible	Possibly Forcibly
Adjectives ending in -ic: + "ally"	Tragic Basic	Tragically Basically
Irregular Adverbs	Fast Straight Hard	Fast Straight Hard

## Structure:

(+) Subject + verb (past) + complement.  
(Regular / Irregular)(-) Subject + did + not + verb (base form) + complement.  
(didn't)

(?) Did + Subject + verb (base form) + complement + ?

(+)	I <b>sent</b> a letter. We <b>traveled</b> to Spain.
	did not= didn't
(-)	I <b>did not send</b> a letter. We <b>didn't traveled</b> to Spain.
(?)	Did you <b>send</b> a letter? Did We <b>travel</b> to Spain?  Answers: Yes, I/you/he/she/it/we/they <b>did</b> . No, I/you/he/she/it/we/they <b>didn't</b> .
