# B. Possessive Pronouns (đại từ sở hữu)

- · Mine, ours, yours, his, hers, and theirs are possessive pronouns.
- Possessive pronoun = possessive adjective + noun (mine = my backpack)
- · Whose asks about possession. Whose book is this? It's my book. / It's mine.
