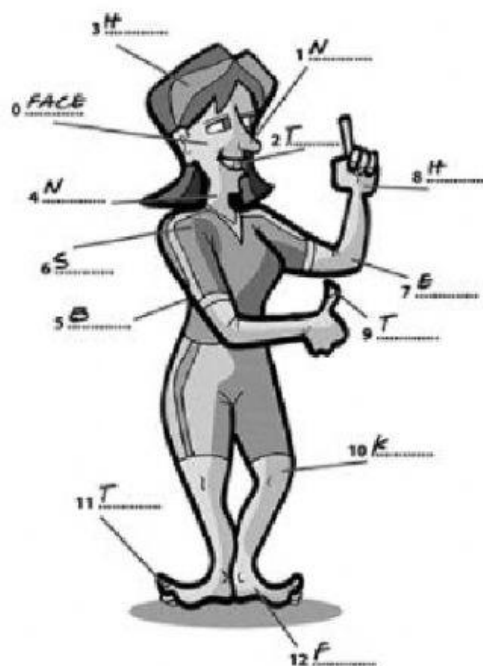

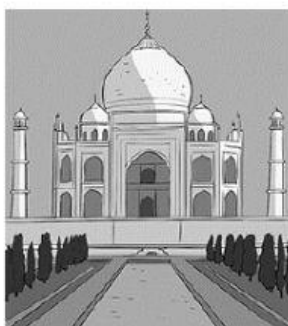

The Taj Mahal

The Taj Mahal is one of India's most famous monuments. The name Taj Mahal means "crown of palaces". Located on a river near the city of Agra, it is made from white marble and dates from the mid-17th century. The palace is famous for its beauty and also for the incredible amount of time (over twenty years) and work (22,000 workers) used in its construction. It is easy to recognise the building because it has got a large white dome. It has a height of around thirty-five metres and is surrounded by four smaller domes. The full height of the Taj Mahal is 171 metres. It is surrounded by beautiful gardens and a large reflecting pool. Millions of visitors from all over the world come to see the Taj Mahal every year.
