Present Simple Tense

We use the **simple present tense** when an action is happening right now, or when it happens regularly. Depending on the person, the **simple present tense** is formed by using the root form or by adding -s or -es to the end.

Remember: Add s, es or ies to the verb only if the subjects are Singular Nouns. (He, She, It)
 : No s, es or ies if the subjects are Plural Nouns. (I, You, We, They)

s/es/ies spelling rules

1. adding "es" to the end of- ss, ch, sh , x, zz, o (watch > watches, guess > guesses, mix > mixes)
2. by changing final "y" to "ies" after a consonant+y (study > studies, party > parties, fly > flies)
3. by adding "s" to the end of a verb (run > runs, sit > sits, see > sees, play > plays)
