 Use 'more', 'less' (according to logic) and the comparative form of the adjective:
1. The more you practice, the (easy) it will be.
2. Please come to the party, the the merrier!
3. Do it as quick as you can, the (soon) the (good)!
4. The teacher explains, and the (simple) his explanation, the the students will understand.
5. The (old) you get, the (slow) you run, but the (far) your knowledge takes you!
