

# Regular Verbs. Most common (Present, Past/Past Participle, from **A** to **D**)

The verbs are words that we use for realizing the actions in our daily routines.

Examples:

- You can accept a new assistant.
- Paul and Mary dance bachata every day at the dancing academy.

## To take it account

In this case, **accept** and **dance** are verbs that realize the actions. The actions to **accept** and to **dance**.

Now, we will see the next verbs in the three times: Present, Simple Past and Past participle.

The regular verbs in past participle are the same in Simple Past. Those verbs always finish in "ed".
