Simple Present

- It is used to express habitual actions, routines
- Signal words: always, never, often, sometimes, usually, regularly, every day, once a month, ...

Present Progressive

- It is used for actions that are happening now, at the time of speaking
- Signal words: now, at the moment, just, right now, at present, today, ...
