



### Simple Present

- ❖ It is used to express habitual actions, routines
- ❖ **Signal words:** always, never, often, sometimes, usually, regularly, every day, once a month, ...

### Present Progressive

- ❖ It is used for actions that are happening now, at the time of speaking
- ❖ **Signal words:** now, at the moment, just, right now, at present, today, ...

 <p>We want to know more about you... Are you learning anything new at the moment?</p>	 <p>Yes! I <u>take / am taking</u> French lessons. I really love visiting France but I want to speak French the next time, too</p>
 <p>How often <u>do you travel / are you travelling?</u></p>	 <p>Always! I <u>travel / am travelling</u> twice a month...</p>
 <p>That's exhausting! Ok, thanks for visiting us.</p>	 <p>Thank you! I <u>have / am having</u> a lot of fun here with you now!</p>
