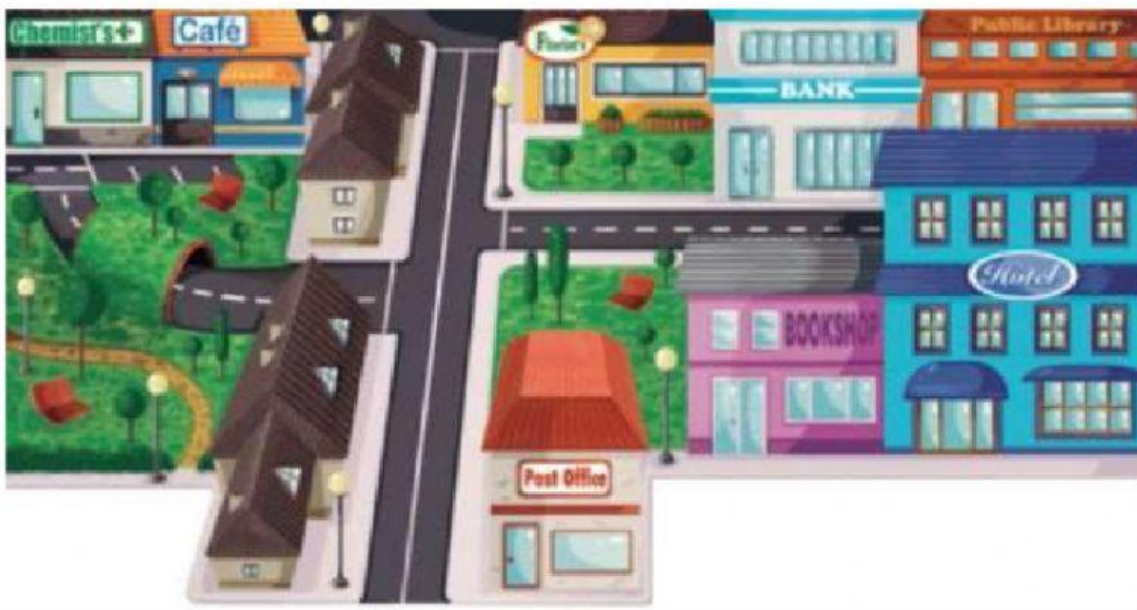
Fiona: Excuse me, can you tell me the way to the bank?
