### 3 Auxiliaries Verb "to be" in the present simple tense

- To simply understand this verb and how it works, it's enough to know that it means

the same as the verb: "être" in French language.

- When we conjugate any verb, we remove "to" of the infinitive form.

Subject	Verb 'to be'	Complement
I	am	an English teacher.
We	are	people.
You	are	a student.
They	are	doctors.
He	is	a man.
She	is	a woman
It	is	an animal.

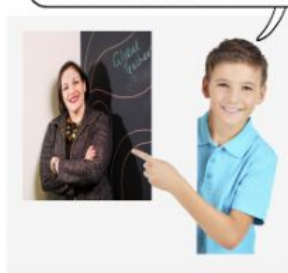
