(not see / yet).



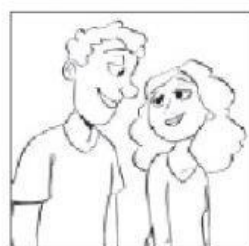
- 9 Mike is very naughty sometimes. He was unkind / relaxed to his little brother and he hasn't said sorry yet.
