Condition	Result
If-clause	Main clause
1) If + Present Simple ,	... Present simple
<i>If I have time,</i>	<i>I read books.</i>
2) If + Present Simple ,	Command ...
<i>If you need me,</i>	<i>call me.</i>
Comma!	

Result	Condition
Main clause	If-clause
1) Present Simple ...	if + Present Simple
<i>I read books</i>	<i>if I have time.</i>
2) Command ...	if + Present Simple
<i>Call me</i>	<i>if you need me.</i>
No comma!	

Zero conditional 1
