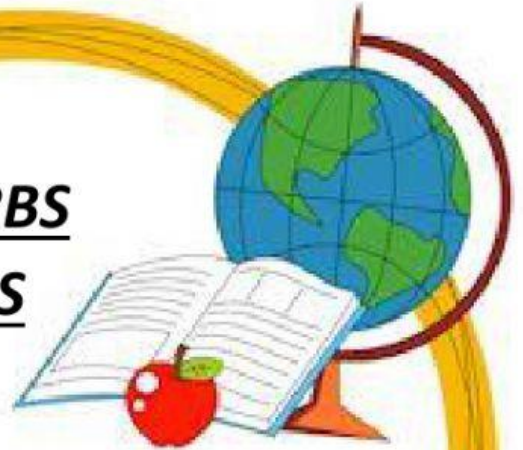




AUXILIARY VERBS **IN QUESTIONS**



Write the correct auxiliary in each gap:

For present simple tense, we use the auxiliary verb: for I, you, we, they and for she, he, it.
The main verb goes in infinitive form.

For present continuous tense, we use the auxiliary verb: *am* for I; you, we, they and for she, he, it.
The main verb is in – ing form.

For past simple tense, we use the same auxiliary verb: for all subjects. The main verb goes in infinitive form.
Remember BE in past: *was* or

For present perfect tense, we use the auxiliary verb: for I, you, we and they and for she, he, it.
The main verb is past participle form.

For future plans and intentions, we use the auxiliary verb: *am* for I; you, we, they and for she, he, it.
The auxiliary verb is followed by "going to" plus an infinitive verb.
