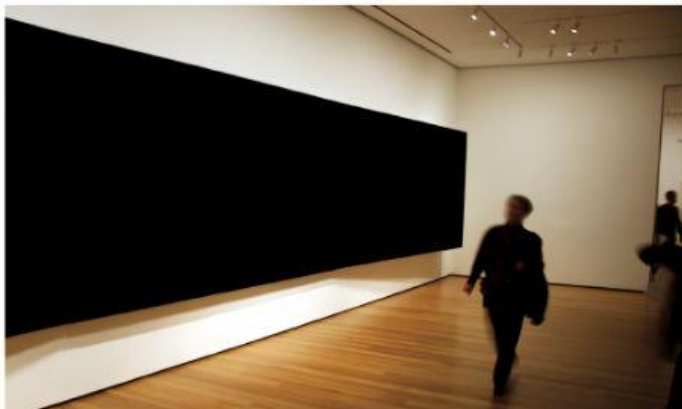




This is a big painting.

Adjective + noun

noun + <i>be</i> + adjective	adjective + noun
These headphones are great.	These are great headphones.
This painting is beautiful.	It's a beautiful painting.
My phone is old.	I have an old phone.

Word order

I have a new phone. ✓ ~~I have a phone new.~~ ✗

TIP Use **a/an** before adjective + single noun

It's **a** beautiful painting. I have **an** old phone.

Key vocabulary **Adjectives:** small, big, tall, short, new, old, young, fast, expensive, cheap
