

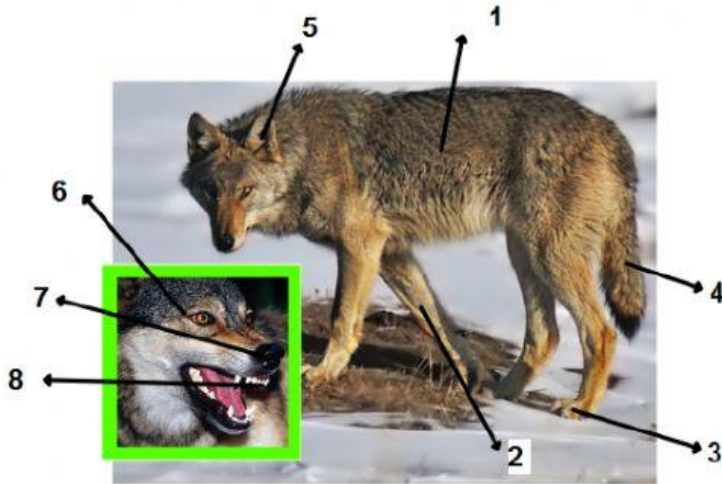
## Forest: Wolves
