Condition	Result
If-clause	Main clause
If + <b>Past Perfect</b> ,	... <b>would + have + past participle</b>
<i>If I <b>had had</b> time,</i>	<i>I <b>would have read</b> books.</i>
<b>Comma!</b>	

Result	Condition
Main clause	If-clause
<b>would + have + past participle ...</b>	if + <b>Past Perfect</b>
<i>I <b>would have read</b> books</i>	<i>if I <b>had had</b> time.</i>
<b>No comma!</b>
