WHAT IS A RHYME?

- A **RHYME** IS A REPETITION OF SIMILAR SOUNDING WORDS. WE FIND THEM AT THE END OF EACH SENTENCE.


FOR EXAMPLE:

The Frog

I saw a little **frog**
He was cuter than can **be**.
He was sitting on a **log**
And I'm sure he croaked at **me!**




