Presentation

"Nominalization" is when you form nouns from other parts of speech, especially from verbs and adjectives. We often use nominalization in more formal texts (e.g., reports, emails or letters, formal presentations).

Verb → noun nominalization

I applied for the job. \rightarrow Please find attached my application for the job.

Did you receive my letter? → Please acknowledge receipt of this letter.

Adjective → noun nominalization

I'm pleased by your interest. \rightarrow I would like to express my pleasure at your interest.

We were disappointed by the decision. → The decision was a great disappointment to us all.

Note: When we nominalize, we often add a preposition after the noun such as receipt of, appreciation for.

Other types of nominalization

We can use nouns to replace relative clauses with pronouns such as who, when, why, what, and where.

I don't know why they didn't come. \rightarrow I don't know the reason for their absence.

Can you tell where you are? → Can you tell me your location?

I can't remember when it happened. \rightarrow I can't remember the occasion.

Does the journalist know who did it? → Does the journalist know the identity of the person?

I couldn't tell you how it was done. \rightarrow I couldn't tell you the method that was used.

I don't know what the movie is about. \rightarrow I don't know the plot of the movie.
