

Spanish Plurals

1. General rules for making a singular noun in Spanish into a plural:
 - For nouns ending in a vowel, add an *-s* to make it plural (*gato* = *gatos*)
 - For nouns that end in a consonant, add *-es* to make it plural (*doctor* = *doctors*)
 - For nouns that end in *-z*, replace the *-z* with *-ces* (*pez* = *peces*)
 - For nouns that refer to a mixed group, use the masculine plural form (2 *gatos* + 1 *gata* = 3 *gatos*)
