

Spanish Plurals

1. General rules for making a singular noun in Spanish into a plural:
 - For nouns ending in a vowel, add an -s to make it plural (gato = gatos)
 - For nouns that end in a consonant, add -es to make it plural (doctor = doctors)
 - For nouns that end in -z, replace the -z with -ces (pez = peces)
 - For nouns that refer to a mixed group, use the masculine plural form (2 gatos + 1 gata = 3 gatos)
