

- A **pronoun** is a word that takes the place of a noun.

Examples: he, she, it, they, someone, that, this, etc.

Types of Pronouns

1. Personal Pronoun
2. Demonstrative Pronoun

- A **personal pronoun** is a short word we use as a simple substitute for the proper name of a person or thing. For eg. He, she, it. I, they, etc.
- A **demonstrative pronoun** is a pronoun that is used to point to something specific within a sentence. For eg: this, that, those and these.
