

Oil Spills

Oil is used to make many things, including plastic, fuels, and everyday products, such as toothpaste and toys. Oil is transported across the oceans by big ships called *tankers*. If there's an accident during the transportation, the oil escapes into the ocean and causes pollution in the area. Accidents like this happened in the past and continue to happen today. Pollution makes the environment unsafe for plants, animals, and humans. Sea life and land life in the area get sick. Many plants and animals die. People can get sick too if we eat the seafood caught in the polluted area.

We must protect the oceans from oil pollution. Tankers must transport oil in a safe way. If there's an oil spill, it has to be cleaned up fast and in a safe way. But the best way to help the oceans from oil pollution is to use fewer oil-based products. Ride your bike, reuse clothes and electronics, and recycle plastic every time you can.


