John Lennon

John Winston Lennon was born on 9 October 1940 in Liverpool, England. He was a famous rock musician, singer, songwriter, artist and peace activist. He gained worldwide recognition as one of the founding members of *The Beatles*. Lennon's mother, Julia, bought him his first guitar in 1957. His Aunt Mimi, who at the time took care of him, never believed Lennon when he said he would be famous one day. Lennon proved his aunt to be wrong when he became very famous with *The Beatles*. The members of this musical group regarded him as the leader. As Paul McCartney once explained: *We all looked up to John. He was older and he was very much the leader – and he was the smartest.* Lennon also had a solo career. He wrote and recorded many songs such as *Imagine* and *Give Peace a Chance*. Lennon revealed his personality not only in his songs but also on television and in films such as *Help!* and *A Hard Day's Night*.

After a retirement period from 1976 to 1980, Lennon reemerged with a new album. But one month later a man called Mark Chapman killed him in New York City on 8 December 1980. In 2002, people voted Lennon the eighth most popular person on the *100 Greatest Britons* on BBC. In 2004, the *Rolling Stone* magazine ranked Lennon number 38 on its list of *'The Immortals: The Fifty Greatest Artists of All Time'*.


