- The subject is the noun or pronoun that usually comes at the **beginning of a sentence**.

Object (O)

The girl has **a puppy**.
She loves **it**.

- The object is the noun or pronoun that comes **after the verb** in a sentence

	Singular	Plural
1st Person	I like apples.	We like apples.
2nd Person	You speak English.	You speak English.
3rd Person	He has a brother.	They have a brother.
	She has a brother.	
	It is on the desk.	They are on the desk.

- **I, we, you, she, he, it and they** are subject pronouns

A subject pronoun takes the place of a subject noun.

Jack is from Canada. He speaks English. **He = Jack**

Mary is from Canada. She speaks English. **She = Mary**

Jack and Mary are from Canada. They speak English.

They = Jack and Mary




2 nd Person	You like Mary.	Mary likes you .	You like Mary.	Mary likes you .

3rd Person He likes Mary. Mary likes **him**. They like Mary.
 She likes Mary. Mary likes **her**. Mary likes **them**.
 It likes Mary. Mary likes **it**.

- **Me, us, you, him, her, it** and **them** are object pronouns.
- An object pronoun takes the place of an object noun.
 Sam is my best friend. I like him very much. **Him = Sam**
 Amy is my best friend. I like her very much. **Her = Amy**
 Sam and Amy are my best Friends. I like them very much.
Them = Sam and Amy.
