A cook is a person **who** makes food. (2 5))  
That's the woman **who** won the lottery last year.  
A clock is something **which** tells the time.  
Is that the book **which** everybody's reading?  
A post office is a place **where** you can buy stamps.  
That's the restaurant **where** I had dinner last week.



- Use defining relative clauses to explain what a person, thing or place is or does.
- Use *who* for a person, *which* for a thing and *where* for a place.

#### **that**

You can use *that* instead of *who* or *which*.  
*She's the girl **who** / **that** works with my brother.*  
*It's a thing **which** / **that** connects two computers.*
