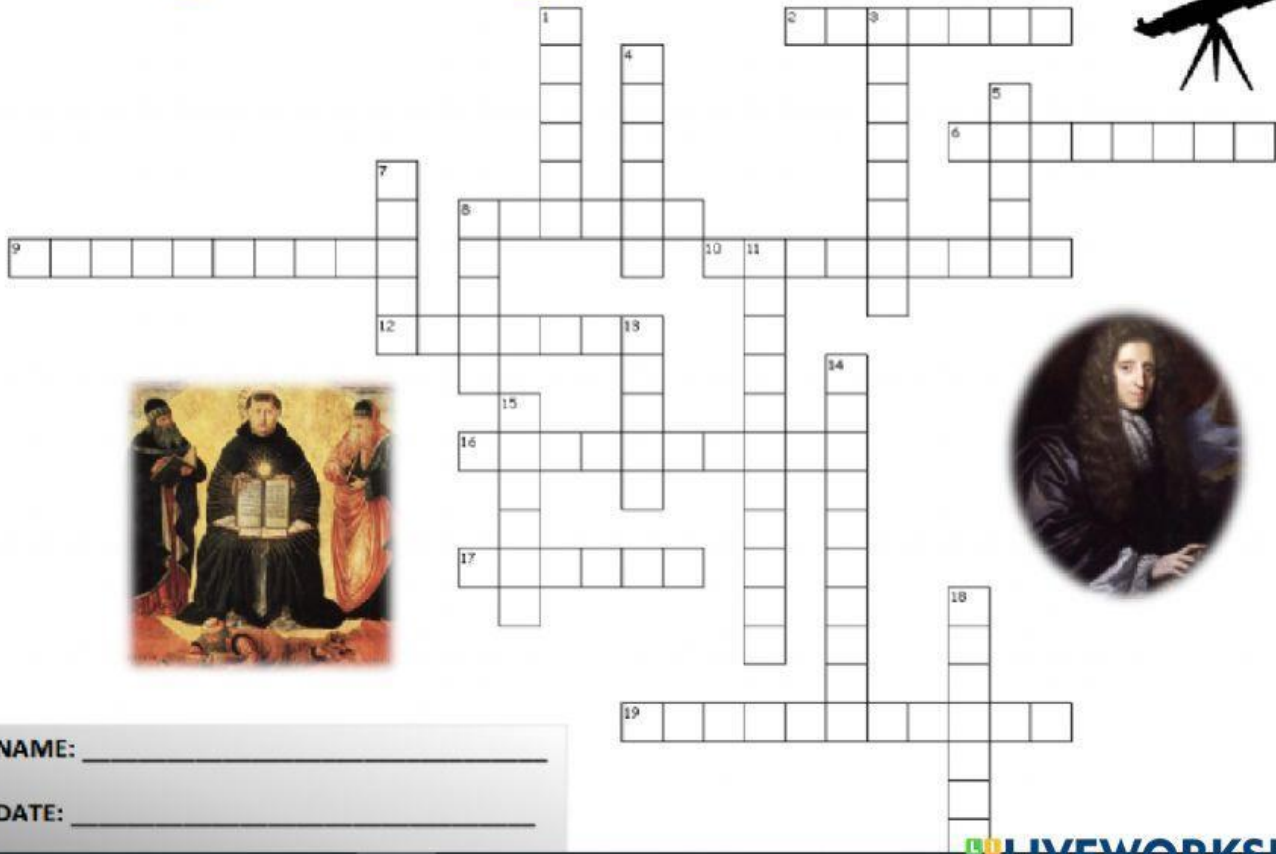

1. This contract or agreement among people to give up their natural rights that results in the organization of society
3. In "The Social Contract" (1762) he argues that laws are binding only when they are supported by the general will of the people
4. The thought that the people ruled were given this right by God
5. Political philosopher, wrote "Two Treatises of Government", claimed that men are by nature free and equal, not that God made them subservient to a monarch
7. English politician, writer. Formalized the empirical method & inductive reasoning
8. Scottish economist/philosopher known as "The Father of Economics" - wrote "The Wealth of Nations"
11. To have a modern, and well-informed outlook
13. The division of this is the idea that people should be assigned a specific role in the assembly process (leads to assembly line)
14. Polish astronomer who produced a workable model of the solar system with the sun in the center
15. Discovered that the paths of the planets around the sun are elliptical rather than circular
