Demolition Call



SOME GRAMMAR: The Causative

In English, we use this structure when we ask or pay somebody to do something for us.

have
get (any tense) *something done* (past participle)

My sister **has her hair cut** every month

My sister **gets her hair cut** every month

I **will have my suitcase brought** from the airport

I **will get my suitcase brought** from the airport

I **didn't have my car repaired** last week

I **didn't get my car repaired** last week
