**Daisy** gets up at quarter past seven. Then she has breakfast and goes to school with her brother. School starts at quarter past eight. She comes home from school at one o'clock. Then Daisy sometimes plays tennis with her friends. Later she does her homework or plays the guitar. After that she watches TV or reads a book. She goes to bed at eleven o'clock.

### A School Day




