## MOTORCYCLES

### PRACTICAL LIVING SKILLS

- 1) MOTORCYCLES HAVE THE SAME RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES AS \_\_\_\_\_ DRIVERS.
- 2) WHILE EVERYONE MUST FOLLOW THE SAME TRAFFIC LAWS, MOTORCYCLISTS FACE ADDITIONAL \_\_\_\_\_ BECAUSE MOTORCYCLES REQUIRE EXCEPTIONAL HANDLING ABILITY AND ARE HARDER TO SEE.

- 4) MOTORCYCLISTS CAN DO MANY THINGS TO INCREASE THEIR CHANCES OF BEING SEEN BY DRIVERS AND OTHER ROAD \_\_\_\_\_, INCLUDING:
  - WEARING A BRIGHT-COLORED JACKET, VEST, AND \_\_\_\_\_.
  - WEARING \_\_\_\_\_ MATERIAL ON HELMETS AND CLOTHES.
  - USING TURN SIGNALS WHEN PLANNING TO \_\_\_\_\_ LANES OR TURN.
  - FLASHING THEIR \_\_\_\_\_ LIGHTS BEFORE SLOWING DOWN TO HELP OTHERS NOTICE THE MOTORCYCLE.
  - AVOIDING BLIND SPOTS OF OTHER VEHICLES AND NOT \_\_\_\_\_ BETWEEN VEHICLES WHEN LANE SPLITTING.
  - USING HIGH BEAM HEADLIGHTS \_\_\_\_\_ DAYLIGHT HOURS.

5) FOLLOW THESE RULES TO RESPECT THE RIGHT-OF-WAY AND SAFELY  
SHARE THE ROAD WITH MOTORCYCLISTS:

- A. WHEN YOU CHANGE LANES OR ENTER A MAJOR THOROUGHFARE,  
MAKE A \_\_\_\_\_ CHECK FOR MOTORCYCLES AND USE  
YOUR MIRRORS.
- B. ALLOW A 4 SECOND FOLLOWING \_\_\_\_\_.
- C. NEVER TRY TO \_\_\_\_\_ A MOTORCYCLE IN THE SAME  
LANE YOU ARE SHARING WITH THE MOTORCYCLE.
- D. WHENEVER POSSIBLE, MOVE TO ONE \_\_\_\_\_ OF YOUR  
LANE TO GIVE MOTORCYCLISTS AMPLE ROOM TO PASS.
- E. WHEN YOU MAKE A TURN, \_\_\_\_\_ FOR MOTORCYCLISTS  
AND GAUGE THEIR SPEED BEFORE TURNING.
- F. LOOK \_\_\_\_\_ FOR MOTORCYCLISTS BEFORE OPENING  
DOORS NEXT TO MOVING TRAFFIC OR BEFORE TURNING RIGHT.
- G. DIFFERENT ROAD CONDITIONS, LIKE POTHOLSE, GRAVEL, WET OR  
SLIPPERY \_\_\_\_\_, PAVEMENT SEAMS, RAILROAD  
CROSSINGS, AND GROOVED PAVEMENT, CAN CAUSE  
MOTORCYCLISTS TO CHANGE SPEED OR DIRECTION SUDDENLY.
