Facts

A dog has four legs.

The sun rises every morning.

The earth is not flat.

Habits

I get up early every day.

Carol brushes her teeth twice a day.

I always drink coffee at work.

True in the present

The Queen of England lives in Buckingham Palace.

He is forty years old.

He works at Microsoft.

Subject	Verb	
I/you/we/they	speak / learn	
he/she/it	speak <mark>s</mark> / learns	

For verbs that end in

-O, -CH, -SH, -SS, -X, or -Z

we add -ES in the third person.

go-goes / catch-catches/ wash-washes

kiss-kisses/ fix -fixes/ buzz-buzzes

Y, we remove the Y and add -IES.
marry - marries / study - studies
carry - carries/ worry - worries


For verbs that end in a **vowel** + **Y**, we just add -**S**.


play - plays / enjoy - enjoys / say - says


