Li Jing

I want to sell wristbands. I will make them myself. I can make twenty wristbands in a month. I plan to sell them at RM6 each. I will need RM20 to buy the cord and RM50 to buy the beads.

We need to spend RM3 on plastic bags to keep the tins in. One full bag of empty tins usually weighs about 1 kilogramme. We can get RM4 for each kilogramme. In a month we can fill five bags.

I plan to sell cookies. I will bake the cookies myself on Sundays. I can make eight bottles of chocolate cookies in a month. I have to buy eight containers at RM5 each. I also need to spend RM50 on the ingredients and another RM15 on labels and decorations for the bottles. I plan to sell the cookies at RM12 a bottle.
