

Complete the sentences with the verbs in bracket using present continuous.

PRESENT CONTINUOUS		
AFFIRMATIVE	NEGATIVE	INTERROGATIVE
You <b>are playing</b> football now.	You <b>are not playing</b> ...	<b>Are</b> you <b>playing</b> ...?
He <b>is visiting</b> his grandmother today.	He <b>is not visiting</b> ...	<b>Is</b> he <b>visiting</b> ...?

- We use present simple and verb TO BE in present simple (am, is, are).
- Use it to talk about things that are happening now and fixed future plans.
