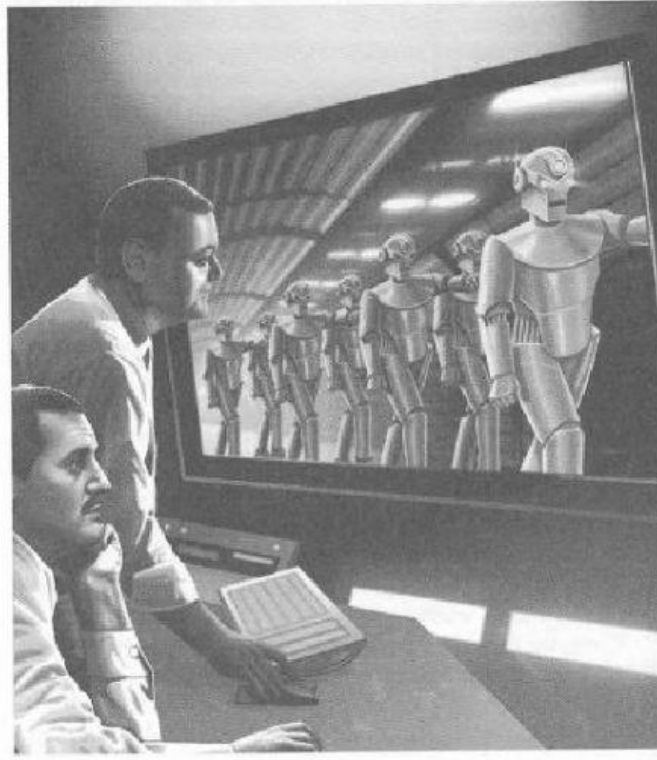

Keywords are one or more words used to indicate the content of your story. Keywords are also the words and phrases that describe a page. With the keyword approach, you can highlight important facts or ideas in a passage, which will help to remember a central idea about the article or passage. Keywords you underline are usually nouns, a group of nouns, or verbs.
