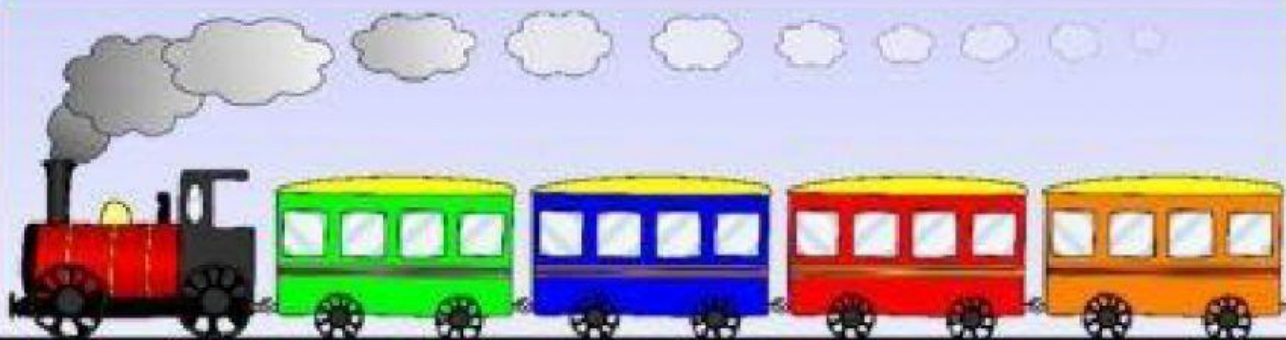




AT THE RAILWAY STATION
