

PAST CONTINUOUS TENSE

Past continuous tense is used to:

A) Talk about actions that were **ongoing in the past**. We cannot determine when the action started or finished.

Example: Alice **was playing** with her brother at home yesterday.

B) Show **interrupted action** in the past.

Example: Sam **was driving** to work when he crashed his car.



S + was/were + V-ing

She was cooking all morning.



S + was/were + not + V-ing

She was not sleeping when he came home.



Was/were + S + V-ing?

Was she sleeping when he came home?

AFFIRMATIVE	NEGATIVE	YES/NO QUESTIONS
I was dancing	I wasn't dancing	Was I dancing?
You were eating	You weren't eating	Were you eating?
He was sleeping	He wasn't sleeping	Was he sleeping?
She was reading	She wasn't reading	Was she reading?
It was running	It wasn't running	Was it running?
We were walking	We weren't walking	Were we walking?
They were studying	They weren't studying	Were they studying?
