At (point)	In (enclosed space)	On (surface)
At the bus stop	In the garden	On the wall
At the door	In Chicago	On the ceiling
At the top of the page	In Russia	On the floor
At the end of the road	In a box	On the cover
At the entrance	In my wallet	On the carpet
At the front desk	In a car	On the menu
At an address		On the internet

Notice the use of the prepositions of place at, in and on in these standard expressions:

At	In	On
At home	In a car	On the bus
At work	In a taxi / In an Uber	On the train
At school	In a helicopter	On a plane
At college	In a hot air balloon	On a ship
At a university	In the newspaper	on the elevator
At the bottom	In the sky	On a horse
At the bank		On the radio/On TV
