READ THE TABLE.

Can you tell me where		the theatre is? the bus stop is?
Go Walk	<b>along</b> King's Road <b>straight on</b>	<b>until</b> you get to the crossroads / the roundabout.
Turn	<b>left</b> <b>right</b>	at the crossroads. at the roundabout.
Go Continue	<b>towards</b> the traffic lights. <b>past</b> the police station. <b>over</b> the bridge.	

We can use the verbs **go**, **walk**, **turn** and **continue** to give directions.
