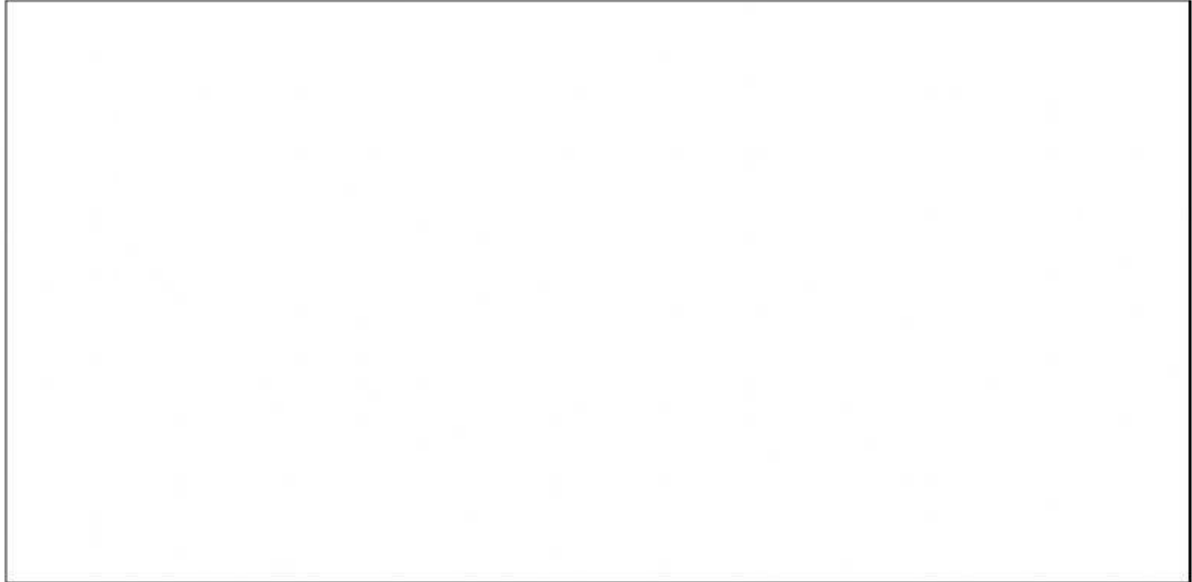



GOOD LUCK AND BAD LUCK

The young villagers were forced to be soldiers. The families were very sad thinking that their sons might end up died in the war.

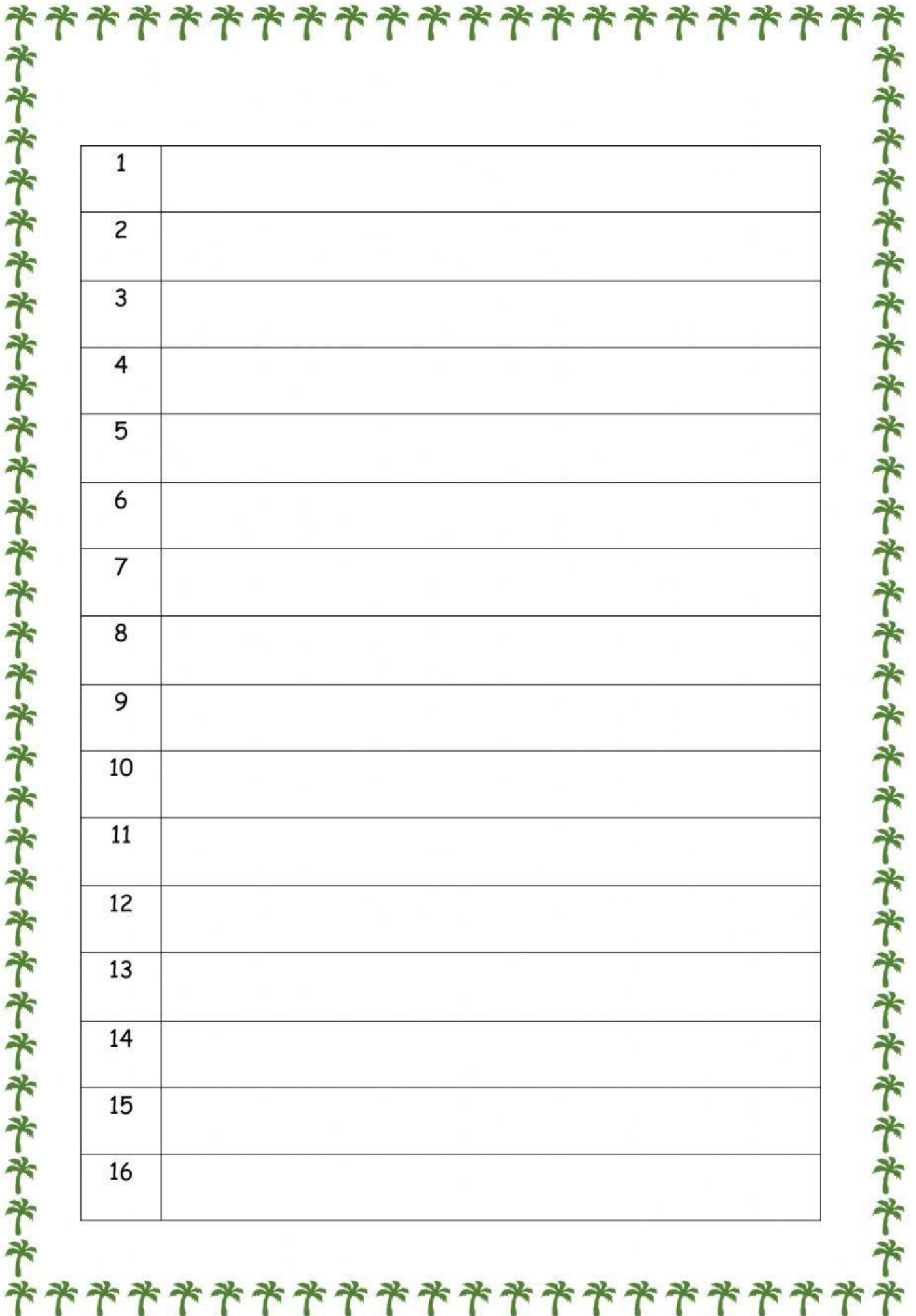
The son was very lucky. His broken leg had saved him from being chosen as the soldiers.
