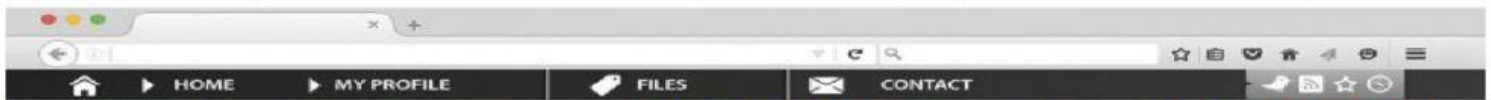

**AP says:**

We study the history of past life on Earth by examining and interpreting fossils.



**AP says:**

No, paleontologists usually check where rocks with fossils might be before they go looking for them. For example, we can find Triceratops bones only in Cretaceous-aged rocks. When we want a Triceratops fossil, we find places with those rocks in books and on geologic maps. Or we can also visit areas where other Triceratops bones were found.



**AP says:**

The Greeks and Romans probably found fossils. Some people think that they interpreted large fossils (like parts of dinosaurs) as many of the giants and monsters of mythology.



**AP says:**

The preserved remains of plants and animals. We consider them true fossils when they are at least 10,000 years old!



**AP says:**

Yes, some fossils are very fragile. But we can use a cast.



**AP says:**

It's a copy of a real fossil. We use casts to study the fossil without breaking the original. We can also make casts for many museums to analyze them.
